What are they and how Can we promote them?

Democracy

Showcase everyone being treated equally and having equal rights. Having a choice alone and in groups.

- Daily choice board- give children the option of what they want to do/play with
- Story time Lay out a selection of books
 and children choose what book to read
- Turn taking you can do this through games, helping around the house and sharing
- Emotions help children to express their emotions and feelings

Individual Liberty

Support children to understand and value their own self and gain confidence in making choices.

- Provide opportunities for risk taking e.g. make obstacle course
- Encourage a range of experiences that explore language of feelings and responsibility, reflect on these differences and understand everyone is free to have a different opinion
- Have discussions about what you have done today and think about others choices

The Rule of Law

Understanding that rules matter and understanding right from wrong.

- Create rules and codes of behaviour together-discuss what is acceptable and what isn't
- Talk about police services and laws that we need to follow
- Talk about services that help us, e.g. fire and ambulance service
- Help children to understand their actions have consequences (good and bad)

Mutual Respect and Tolerance

Treating others how you want to be treated and learning to understand and appreciate each others differences.

- Share stories from home that reflect the values and the diversity of their experiences
- Respecting others opinions and feelings

 use listening skills
- Visit the wider community e.g. elderly peoples homes and religious festivals
