

What is FOODclub?



FOODclubs are open in Children's Centres and community venues in Bristol. They aim to reduce food wastage and provide local families with a range of quality food at the low cost of £3.50 per week.

They offer variety of food items each week. All of the food will always be within its 'Use by' date, but food may sometimes have gone past its 'Best before' date. This food is still perfectly fine to eat and you will be made aware if this is the case.

How does it work?

- Contact your local food club, complete an application form and pay your £1 annual joining fee.
- A time slot will be given to you each week to collect your food.
- There will be a weekly charge of £3.50 per food bag payable on collection. This will pay for a selection of groceries worth from £10 - £15.
- Tell staff if you have any food allergies or dietary requirements.
- All frozen and refrigerated food must be taken home in a chill bag (available to purchase for either £1 or £2 or bring your own)
- You must be 16 or over and named on the form can collect food.
