



Rockets



- Scissors
- Glue
- Coloured Paper





- Start by cutting out different shapes. You can make them different colours and different sizes.
- 2 Lay the shapes out on a table with a glue stick and get rocket making. Let your child experiment with the shapes and encourage them to talk to you about the shapes.



Here are some questions you could ask your child:

- I wonder what shapes are you going to use?
- · What can you make with these shapes?
- How can you use these shapes to make other shapes?
- Can you find different sizes of the same shapes?
- I wonder how many colours you will use?

Try to keep your questions and comments open-ended so your child will have time to think about their responses.

You can also comment on what your child is doing, as this is a really effective way to show you are focussed on them.
