

Shaving Foam Mark Making



Things you'll need:

- Paint
- Plastic zip sandwich bag
- Shaving foam
- Tape



1. Pour a different colours of paint into the corners of the sandwich bag.



2. Fill the bag with shaving foam. Carefully remove all the air from the sandwich bag, then zip the top the bag up. Cover the top of the sandwich bag with tape to make it extra secure.



3. Children can now mix the paint colours and the shaving foam together. Children can develop their hand-eye coordination by making marks in the foam.

Ask your children some questions to extend their learning.

- What colours does it make?
- How does it feel?
- Can you smell the shaving foam?
- What does it smell like?

Top Tip

The shaving foam mixture can be used as paint for further sensory exploration.
