

Firework Painting



Things you'll need:

- Paint (a few different colours)
- Paper
- Cardboard Tubes
- Glitter (optional)



1. Snip around the cardboard tube to create a fan effect and try cut them into different lengths to create different size firework prints.



2. Dip the cardboard tube into the paint, use a 'bounce and twist' motion to print onto the paper.



3. You can add a small amount of glitter to the wet paint to finish off the 'fireworks' effect!

Sparkler Safety Tips

1. Always wear gloves with sparklers.
2. Don't let your children light the sparklers themselves. Have an adult do it.
3. Don't give sparklers to children under 5.
4. Keep sparklers away from other people's faces.
5. Never hold a baby in your arms when you are holding a sparkler.
6. When the sparkler has finished, put it into a bucket of cold water straight away.
