

Make a daffodil



Items that you will need:

- A piece of paper
- Pencils and crayons
- Scissors
- A straw or lolly stick
- Tape or glue



1. Draw an outline of a daffodil flower head.



2. Cut out your flower shape and also cut out 2 or 3 different sized circles.



3. Stick the circles in size order to the centre of your flower. Stick your lolly stick or straw to the back. Then you have made your daffodil!



Top tip: This is an opportunity to talk to your child about shapes and sizes. It is also a good hand eye co-ordination skill with the scissors. Please support your child with the scissors.
